

Linux Command List

Here's a bonus cheat sheet from <https://linuxhit.com> to you.

Command	Description
ls	Lists all files and directories in the present working directory
ls -r	Lists sub-directories too
ls -a	Lists hidden files
ls path -l more	Lists files and directories within pages
cat > filename	Creates a new file
cat filename	Prints a file's content to the console
cat fileone filetwo > filethree	Joins two files (fileone and filetwo) in a new file (filethree)
mv filename "file path"	Moves the files to another directory
mv filename.txt renamefile.txt	Renames a file
sudo	Allows commands to run with privileges of superuser or root
rm file	Deletes a file
pwd	Prints the current working directory in the console
mkdir	Creates a new directory
cp -r filename "filepath"	Copies the entire directory and it's files
cp filename "filepath"	Copies a file from the current directory a different one
rmdir	Deletes a directory
mv	Renames a directory
touch	Creates a new empty file
cd	Goes to a specified directory
cd ..	Move up a directory
cd ~	Moves to the home directory
clear	Clears the console
exit	Closes the console
